An Update from the Office for Safeguarding

Safe Parishes Week - Safeguarding Mandatory Training is Due Now!

Are you new to Parish Ministry this year and have not completed your Safeguarding Training?

Are you an existing volunteer and have not yet completed your 6 points of mandatory Safeguarding Training?

Under the Children's Guardian Act 2019 and the NSW Child Safe Standards **all** volunteers in parish ministry are Mandatory Reporters and are required to have completed their Safeguarding Training. The Office of the Children's Guardian expects all volunteers in parish ministry have now met this Standard. In the Diocese of Parramatta we have a zero tolerance of abuse. We therefore commit to keeping children safe as well as all adults at risk.

You are now required to register for the Mandatory 6 points of Safeguarding Training to complete Cycle 1: Register for the Mandatory Training during Safe Parishes Week on:

Friday 9th June at 9.30am - 2.30pm at Bishop Bede Heather Centre, Marion Street Blacktown

JUNE 17 SYNOD CONSULTATION

Two weeks ago we had a letter in the Bulletin about
this consultation and what it may involve.

I asked you to pray about it, asking the Holy Spirit to
help discern God's will.

Synodality is about the whole Diocese working
together, as a local church, as a communion of
disciples, to carry out the mission of Christ in the
world. All the members of the church in our
Diocese have to work together and listen to each
other, while remaining true to Jesus Christ, if we are
to do this.

I asked you to pray about this and for it to
successfully take place in our Diocese and our
parish. I would ask you to do so again over the
coming week.

Remember that we are asking the Holy Spirit to
enable us to discern His will, which is the will of God
the Father and God the Son, for ourselves and our
local church. In Romans 12.1 the Holy Spirit has
given us the conditions for this, namely:

1 - That we offer our bodies as a "living sacrifice,
holy and pleasing to God". This means that we are
living the commandments, not a self-indulgent life
style, and that we are practicing our faith for the
mass is the key to offering of our bodies with that of
Jesus.

2 - That we think with the new mind given to us,
that is that we think with the mind of Jesus given to
us through faith. We are specifically told not to think
with the mind of world we live in.
